



Required Parent Participation Hours (PPH) per Family (PreK-5th Grade)

The success of Christ the King School not only rests on the hard work and dedication of its staff, but also on the dedication of its parents. We want our families to be a part of the school experience with their children. In order to keep tuition rates down, we organize events throughout the school year that help cover the cost of new materials, technology, building maintenance, etc. Parent involvement in fundraising and other events at the school is an essential part of Christ the King's continuing success. Parents have the opportunity to directly influence the direction and purpose of the school by their participation.

Each family who has a child attending CTK School or Preschool, whether part-time or full-time, is required to complete 16 PPH with a mandatory 3 hours worked at the annual Parish Carnival in May.

Each hour of the regular hours not served results in a monetary compensation of \$50 per hour. Carnival hours not served will result in a monetary compensation of a total of \$500.

As a reminder, each hour worked must be a school-sponsored event and benefit the school in some capacity.

Because of COVID-19, some PPH hours for the previous school year were waived. With the reduction in hours already this year, we will not be waiving any of the requirements.

The PTO Committee will work to find creative ways to incorporate a lot of our activities and events into the School Year and there will be a need for parent participation and cooperation to ensure the success of these activities.

Please note you must attend events and fundraisers as a Volunteer to earn PPH. You cannot claim PPH time if you are attending an event as a parent, with the exception of PTO meetings.

For instance, attending the Tents, Trunks & Treats not as a volunteer worker would not earn PPH.
